Jamestown Area School District State Health Requirements for School Entry

The Pennsylvania Department of Health requires students to have current physical exams in grades K, 6 & 11 & current dental exams in K, 3 and 7. Both must be up to date for new students upon entry into the school district. Immunizations must be up-to-date as determined by the Pa Department of Health. Please place your child's physical & dental forms and current immunization record in an envelope and turn in to the Jamestown Area School District Secretary prior to the first day of school.

We suggest these exams be completed by the student's own physician and dentist. It is felt that your child's own health care provider is in the best position to evaluate your child and follow- up with necessary care. This ensures continuity of care.

<u>Physical and Dental appointments will need to be made in a timely manner to ensure all necessary</u> health information is turned in before the first day of school.

Immunizations may be provided through your local State Health Department at a lower cost.
