WHAT IS THE BEST WAY TO USE THIS FILE?

Please note that this list of scholarships/contests is by no means a comprehensive listing of all scholarships/contests that a student may be eligible for. In reality, there are thousands of scholarships/contests that are available to students each year which come from a variety of sources including local, regional, state and national agencies, organizations, employers, clubs and other resources. This list will continue to be updated as new information is received.

Based on the availability of year-to-year scholarship/contest monies, some scholarships/contests that have been available to students in the past may no longer be available. Scholarships/contests which have not been in effect for more than two years will be removed from the list.

HOW ARE THE SCHOLARSHIPS/CONTESTS ARRANGED?

The information for each individual scholarship/contest is provided in the form of a “fact sheet” which gives a brief summary of the scholarship/contest including the name, eligibility criteria, process for applying, and award amount(s) if known. Whenever possible, website links have been added for your convenience in the event that you would like to apply or simply want additional information on the scholarship/contest. This allows a student or parent/guardian to quickly read through the information and decide whether or not they would like to apply for the scholarship/contest.

The scholarship/contest fact sheets in this file are arranged in order of their general deadline (although, some deadline are subject to change from year to year) and then alphabetically by name of the scholarship/contest.

GUIDELINES FOR APPLYING FOR A SCHOLARSHIP

- Make sure to follow ALL directions and meet ALL deadlines.
- If you need to have transcripts attached, make sure you let Mrs. Haines know at least one week prior to the scholarship deadline.
- If you need letters of recommendation attached, let your teacher or counselor know at least two weeks in advance.
- Generate and provide a list of activities, accomplishments, awards, etc. that you have earned in school, the community, church, etc. to the person you are requesting a letter of recommendation from.
- Keep a copy of the scholarship application for your own records.
- Put time and thought into an essay question, if you are asked to write one. Ask one of the English teachers if he or she would be willing to review your essay, and assist you in making corrections if necessary.
- When in doubt, ask questions! But, don't wait until the last minute.
